Here we are, already in July! A few things have been happening at the Authority that we want to share with our customers.

The Authority is continuing to explore the possibility of a new well at Dietrich's Park. The need for more water supply in the future is very real. By exploring now, rather than later will help to reduce the cost to develop a new source of supply. As permits and reviews can take upwards of a year or more, the Authority is working toward being ready when the time comes.

Anyone who drives back Tuckerton Road has sure seen the activity taking place at the Tuckerton Road Elevated Storage Tank. The Authority has contracted to have the tank painted, both inside and outside. Currently, tarps are being placed around the tank to create a containment area around the entire tank. Within the next week, the contractors will begin sand blasting the outside of the tank in preparation of painting. The containment area will keep the dust and debris within the tarped area and will help to reduce the noise created by the sand blasting. Below are a few photos showing the progress:





When the tarps come down, you will get the first look at a freshly painted storage tank. The project is scheduled to be completed by mid to late September.
