

## DRINKING WATER WARNING

### BOIL YOUR WATER BEFORE USING

### HIERV AN EL AGUA ANTES DE USARLA.

A water main break has occurred in the Muhlenberg Township Authority water supply.

This break effects people served in the Muhlenberg Township Water System.

#### What should I do?

**DO NOT DRINK THE WATER WITHOUT BOILING IT FIRST.** Bring all water to a boil, let it boil for one minute, and let it cool before using, or use bottled water. Boiled or bottled water should be used for drinking, making ice, brushing teeth, washing dishes, and food preparation **until further notice**. Boiling kills bacteria and other organisms in the water.

If you experience any of these symptoms and they persist, contact your doctor. People with severely compromised immune systems, infants, and some elderly may be at increased risk. These people should seek advice about drinking water from their health care providers.

#### What happened? What is being done?

There was a water main break at 2021 Reservoir Rd Alsace Township PA. Water main break was isolated within 1 block. A repair band was installed while the line was under pressure. Boil advisory was issued less than 24 hours after the main was put back into service. Only due to a few customers having lower than normal pressures because of their elevation in relation to the water supply tank. The properties that are effected by the "Boil Water Advisory" are within Wedge Lane and 2014 Reservoir Road through 2028 Reservoir Road.

This boil water advisory will remain in effect until tests show NO signs of coliform bacteria for 2 consecutive days.
